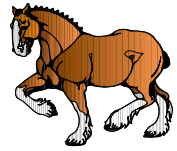

EXHIBITOR TICKETS: \$12.00 FOR (5) DAY OR \$5.00 FOR (1) DAY  
GATE OF ENTRY: ALL EXHIBITORS TO ENTER THE FAIRGROUNDS AT THE NORTHWEST ENTRANCE AND PROCEED TO (GATE 5) LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE FAIRGROUNDS. ENTER FROM UNIVERSITY ENTRANCE. FOR GPS PURPOSES PLEASE USE THE FOLLOWING ADDRESS 6695 N. UNIVERSITY STREET. THIS IS WITHIN 400 FEET OF OUR NORTH UNIVERSITY STREET ENTRANCE.

1. PREMISE REGISTRATION IS VOLUNTARY TO EXHIBIT LIVESTOCK (beef, dairy, horses, swine, sheep, goats, poultry and rabbits). Choosing to register your premises puts you on the frontline of controlling and preventing the spread of animal disease,. A disease outbreak can't be predicted but it can impact every segment of animal agriculture. Participation ensures that you have the information you need, when you need it most, to protect your animals and your investment. Registering a premises involves obtaining a seven-character alpha-numeric "identifier" for the farm, ranch, veterinary clinic or other site where livestock or fowl are handled, housed, managed or processed. If an exhibitor wants to register their animals an application form can be found on-line at [www.agri.state.il.us/premiseid](http://www.agri.state.il.us/premiseid). Exhibitors who register on-line will receive a premises registration number immediately. An application can also be obtained by calling 1-866-299-9256. If completing application and returning by mail, it may take up to 4 weeks to receive the number. 2. ALL MONIES FOR FEES AND TICKETS MUST BE SENT WITH ENTRY.
3. EACH EXHIBITOR ENTERING COMPETITION MUST PURCHASE AT LEAST (1) EXHIBITOR TICKET - \$12.00 FOR 5 DAYS, OR (1) ADMISSION TICKET FOR \$5.00 PLUS PAY ENTRY FEE FOR EACH ENTRY, PLUS A \$5.00 STALL FEE PER HEAD.
4. **PREMIUM LIMITATIONS** - No more than two prizes will be awarded an exhibitor under one lot number.
5. ANIMALS MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS AND READY TO SHOW BY 3:00 P.M. ON JULY 13, 2012. They will be released as soon as the show is completed.
6. The barns will be available on Thursday, July 12, 2012 after 8:00 p.m. or by permission of Superintendent. You will also be allowed to use the barns Thursday night.
7. **All horse trailers must be parked in the designated parking lot. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
8. All out of state horses must present coggins test papers and health papers prior to showing.
9. All Illinois horses must have negative coggins test papers.
10. If extra entry blanks or flyers are needed you may photocopy them or call the Fair office at (309) 691-6332.
11. **THIS SHOW WILL BE BY ENTRY ONLY. REGULAR ENTRY DEADLINE IS JULY 1, 2012. ENTRIES RECEIVED IN THE MAIL MUST BE POSTMARKED BY THE ENTRY DEADLINE OF JULY 1, 2012. THE HEART OF ILLINOIS FAIR RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REJECT ANY OR ALL ENTRIES.**
12. LATE ENTRY DEADLINE: Late entries must be submitted IN PERSON if it is after the July 1<sup>ST</sup> regular deadline. Entries will be accepted between July 1, 2012 and Noon, July 9, 2012 in person at the Heart of Illinois Fair office under the late entry rules. Each late entry will be charged an ADDITIONAL \$4.00 EXTRA PER ENTRY (LOT). Phone entries must be made by 12:00 Noon, July 9, 2012.
13. The Superintendent of the Draft Show has the right to change the order of showing, if a meeting is held with all entered exhibitors and the Superintendent and an agreement is reached between the two parties.
14. **ALL ANIMALS ARE TO BE OUT OF THE BARN BY 6:00 A.M.,SATURDAY, JULY 14, 2012.**

**HORSES, PONIES, MULES AND OTHER EQUINE**

**Illinois Equine**

1. All horses and other equidae, twelve (12) months of age and older attending an advertised equine event, shall be accompanied by a negative test for equine infectious anemia (EIA) conducted within the last twelve (12) months. A copy of this test shall accompany the animal.
2. AGID (Coggins) or ELISA tests are accepted.
3. An advertised equine event means a show, rodeo, sale, auction, exhibition, trail ride, or horse fair that is posted or media promoted.
4. A CVI is not required for Illinois equine.

**Out-of-State Equine**

1. All out-of-state equine are to be accompanied by an entry permit. Permits are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week by calling (217) 782-4944.
2. All horses and other equidae entering Illinois that are twelve (12) months of age or older, shall be accompanied by a negative test for equine infectious anemia (EIA) conducted within the last twelve (12) months. A copy of this test shall accompany the animal.
3. AGID (Coggins) or ELISA tests are accepted.
4. All horses and other equidae shall be accompanied by a CVI issued within thirty (30) days prior to entry.
