DEPARTMENT AND HEART OF ILLINOIS FAIR GENERAL RULES

1. Entries close July 1, 2007. All entries by mail must be postmarked not later than midnight, July 1, 2007, and must be accompanied by the full entry fee. **LATE ENTRY DEADLINE--Entries submitted after the July 1ST regular deadline will be accepted IN PERSON at the Heart of Illinois fair office between July 1, 2007, and Noon, July 9, 2007, under the late entry rule. Entries made during the late entry time period will be charged an additional \$4.00 per entry. Entries close when pens/or stalls are full.**
2. Fees. Each junior exhibitor must purchase at least one \$12.00 (5) day exhibitor ticket and will then receive one (1) five day helper pass free. The exhibitor ticket of \$12.00 plus \$5.00 per lot entry fee and \$7.00 per head stall fee must accompany all applications for entry except champion lots. Group lots must be entered before the July 1, 2007, deadline. There is a \$6.00 entry fee for each group lot entered. Juniors that have a group entry, enter in the open show only. Stall fees are paid only once for animals stalled on grounds. No refunds will be made. Please use the YELLOW entry form marked JUNIOR LIVESTOCK ENTRY ONLY. Please complete all sections of the entry form fully. **AN ENTRY BLANK IS REQUIRED FOR EACH DEPARTMENT.**
3. **CATTLE HEALTH PAPERS WILL BE CHECKED TUESDAY, JULY 17, 2007 AFTER NOON, AT SHEEP/SWINE BARN. NO PREMIUMS WILL BE PAID AND NO ANIMAL WILL BE ALLOWED TO SHOW IF REGISTRATION PAPERS ARE NOT CHECKED.**
4. Please check both the GENERAL RULES section and the Illinois Department of Agriculture Rules at the front of the book as they may apply to your entry. **A HEALTH CERTIFICATE IS REQUIRED FOR BEEF CATTLE PLEASE SEE PAGES THE BEEF SECTION OF THE DEPT. OF AG RULES SECTIONS.**
5. Entries for the Junior Show are limited to boys and girls living in the State of Illinois. Parents or guardians must reside in the State of Illinois and all exhibitors must not have reached their 19th birthday as of September 1, 2007. The management reserves the right to close the entries when a sufficient number have been received to fill the stalls. Name and registry number of each animal must accompany entry.
6. Beef cattle will be dismissed at 12:00 Noon, Wednesday, July 18, 2007.

Ownership of Animals

- 7. To be eligible for competition all animals must be the property of the junior exhibitor, based upon the records of the breed registry associations at the time the entries close, excepting when otherwise specified.
- 8. Firms and co-partnerships entering animals for competition must be bona fide, and must be in existence prior to the time entries are made. Firms and co-partnerships organized, for show purposes only, will not be recognized. Animals owned in partnership may be shown by one partner only.
- 9. No calf under 3 months of age at the time of the fair will be eligible to show, except in the cow/calf lots.
- 10. All animals in the purebred lots must be recorded or accepted for record in the recognized book of record for the respective breeds.
- 11. Animals that have been erroneously entered may, at the discretion of the superintendent, be transferred to their proper lot previous to judging.
- 12. Only animals entered and shown in individual lots are eligible to compete in group and herd lots.
- 13. Animals owned by Jr. Exhibitors will be allowed to show in group lots under a farm or family name if they are a member of the farm or family.
- 14. All exhibitors that use tie-out area must clean-up the area prior to being dismissed.

Competition

- 15. Not more than two prizes will be awarded an exhibitor under one lot number.

Call of Lots

- 16. NO ANIMALS WILL BE RELEASED EARLY.
- 17. Exhibitors must submit their animals for examination by the official veterinarian, when so ordered by the superintendent of the department.
- 18. CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRY MUST BE SHOWN, IF CALLED FOR BY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THIS DEPARTMENT.
- 19. **NO TIE OUTS ARE AVAILABLE. LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS WILL BE REQUIRED TO BRING THEIR OWN GATES FOR TIE OUT PURPOSES.**
- 20. At the discretion of the superintendent, and if numbers warrant, an additional heifer lot may be added.
- 21. All waste straw and manure must be placed in containers provided on NORTH SIDE of livestock barns. Exhibitors failing to do so shall forfeit premium money earned.
- 22. **All exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning their own tie out area.**

The Junior Show Heifers will be broken into lots by the Superintendent using the same criteria as the Open Show. These lots will be showing with the Open Lots. Junior Exhibitors can also enter the Open Show by paying and filling out a WHITE entry form; and, therefore, will be eligible to win premiums in both the Open and Junior competition.

1. All steers must have calf mouth (all baby teeth), no permanent teeth.
2. Steers will be weighed at 12:00 NOON, Sunday, July 16, 2007. A screening committee will be used in determining proper breed lot.
3. The management reserves the right to disqualify any steer for overage or to make proper entry of any steer not in the class which the management feels their breed characteristics represent.
4. All steers are subject to blood type test.
