DEPARTMENT AND HEART OF ILLINOIS FAIR GENERAL RULES

1. PREMISE REGISTRATION IS VOLUNTARY TO EXHIBIT LIVESTOCK (beef, dairy, horses, swine, sheep, goats, poultry and rabbits). Choosing to register your premises puts you on the frontline of controlling and preventing the spread of animal disease. A disease outbreak can't be predicted but it can impact every segment of animal agriculture. Participation ensures that you have the information you need, when you need it most, to protect your animals and your investment. Registering a premises involves obtaining a seven-character alpha-numeric "identifier" for the farm, ranch, veterinary clinic or other site where livestock or fowl are handled, housed, managed or processed. If an exhibitor wants to register their animals an application form can be found on-line at www.agri.state.il.us/premiseid. Exhibitors who register on-line will receive a premises registration number immediately. An application can also be obtained by calling 1-866-299-9256. If completing application and returning by mail, it may take up to 4 weeks to receive the number. 2. Entries close July 1, 2010. All entries by mail must be postmarked not later than midnight, July 1, 2010, and must be accompanied by the full entry fee. **LATE ENTRY DEADLINE--Entries submitted after the July 1st regular deadline will be accepted IN PERSON at the Heart of Illinois Fair office between July 1, 2010, and Noon, July 5, 2010, under the late entry rule. Entries made during the late entry time period will be charged an additional \$4.00 per entry. Entries close when pens/or stalls are full.**
3. Fees. Each junior exhibitor must purchase at least one \$12.00 (5) day exhibitor ticket and will then receive one (1) five day helper pass free. The exhibitor ticket of \$12.00 plus \$3.00 per lot fee and \$3.50 per head pen fee must accompany all applications for entry. Heart of Illinois Market Lamb entries will be \$7.50 per entry in addition to the Exhibit ticket cost. Heart of Illinois Market Lamb entries will be \$7.50 per entry in addition to the Exhibitor ticket cost, if you are making Market Lamb only entries you may elect to purchase a (1) Day \$5.00 exhibitor ticket. If you make both junior and market entries you must purchase the (5) Day \$12.00 exhibitor ticket. Entry fees are paid only once for animals stalled on grounds. Please use the YELLOW entry form marked JUNIOR LIVESTOCK ENTRY ONLY. Please complete all sections for the entry form fully.
4. **A SEPARATE ENTRY BLANK IS REQUIRED FOR EACH DEPARTMENT.**
5. **HEALTH PAPERS WILL BE CHECKED SAT., JULY 17, 2010 AT 10:00 AM IN THE SHEEP BARN. HEALTH PAPERS ARE REQUIRED ON ILLINOIS SHEEP. NO PREMIUMS WILL BE PAID AND NO ANIMALS WILL BE ALLOWED TO SHOW IF REGISTRATION PAPERS ARE NOT CHECKED.**
6. Please check both the GENERAL RULES section and the Illinois Department of Agriculture Rules at the front of the book as they may apply to your entry.

7. Entries for the Junior Show are limited to boys and girls living in the State of Illinois. Parents or guardians must reside in the State of Illinois and all exhibitors must not yet be nineteen (19) years of age on or before September 1 of the year previous to the fair.
8. **ABSOLUTELY NO DOGS IN THE SHEEP BARN.**
9. Market lambs will weigh in immediately following the Breeding Show on Saturday. Only one weight per lamb. No re-weighs.
10. Ewe and Ram Lambs must be showing lamb teeth.
11. Pen of lambs shall consist of three lambs under one year, both sexes represented, owned by exhibitor.
12. All animals must be owned and recorded in the name of the exhibitor and shown by the owner unless he or she is showing in two classes. In that case a helper must be another Junior Exhibitor. Application for registry and transfer, phone calls, correspondence or breeder verification will be accepted in lieu of registration papers.
13. No animals will be released before 8:00 pm, Saturday, July 17, 2010. Any lambs shown in any of the market lamb classes ARE NOT eligible for any breeding classes. Market lambs will be released at the conclusion of the Market Lamb Show.
14. No more than two premiums will be paid an exhibitor in individual lots and only one premium in group lots.
15. All waste straw and manure must be placed in containers provided on NORTH SIDE of livestock barns. Exhibitors failing to do so shall forfeit premium money earned.
16. No livestock or equipment will be allowed in the barn until the superintendent has assigned stalls. Prior arrangements must be made for preferential stalling. No exhibitor will be allowed to move to a different stall once your stall has been assigned. No grooming chutes will be allowed in the barns.
17. If at all possible please mail one person, per envelope, per check or money order when making your entries.
18. Any animal breed that has less than (3) entries in a lot number will show in Class K-All other Breeds.
19. Any breed having less than (2) exhibitors for (2) consecutive years will be eliminated.

FOLLOWING ARE THE RULES SPECIFIC TO THE NEW HEART OF ILLINOIS MARKET LAMB SHOW.

1. Market animals must arrive by 10:00 a.m., Saturday, July 17, 2010. Market lambs will be released at the conclusion of the Market Lamb Show.
2. Wethers and ewes are both eligible and shown together.
3. Market lambs will weigh in immediately following the Combined Breeding Show on Saturday. Only one weight per lamb. No re-weights.
4. Market lamb show will be after the Combined Breeding Sheep show, but not before 1:00 p.m., Saturday, July 17, 2010.
5. Fees: Entry fee for each entry will be \$7.50 for each Junior Market Lamb entry; and \$7.50 for each Open Market Lamb entry.
6. Unlimited entries per exhibitor. If the only entries you are making are in the Market Lamb Show you may purchase a (1) Day \$5.00 exhibitor ticket. If you are making other entries you must purchase a (5) Day \$12.00 exhibitor ticket.
7. The 2009 Heart of IL Market Lamb Show will follow the guideline set by Illinois Club Lamb Association.
8. Lambs will be classified according the All American Junior Show Classification System. Classifier's decision is final!
9. Classes will be split according to breed weight and number of entries. IF A BREED HAS LESS THAN FIVE LAMBS ENTERED THE LAMBS WILL BE PLACED IN AN ALL OTHER BREED DIVISION, which will include brockleheaded lambs. Committee reserves the right to set class/lots.
10. The International Association of Fairs & Expositions National Code of Ethics will be followed.
11. No dyeing, drenching, spray painting or icing of lambs prior to/during the show.
12. All market lambs must have ear tag or legible tattoos.
13. Any Animal breed that has less than (3) entries in a lot number will show in Class K-All other Breeds.
14. Any breed having less than (2) exhibitors for (2) consecutive years will be eliminated.
