**DEPARTMENT AND HEART OF ILLINOIS FAIR GENERAL RULES**

1. Entries close July 1, 2007. All entries by mail must be postmarked no later than Midnight, July 1, 2007, and must be accompanied by the full entry fee. LATE ENTRY DEADLINE—Entries submitted after the July 1<sup>st</sup> regular deadline will be accepted IN PERSON at the Heart of Illinois Fair Office Between July 1, 2007 and Noon, July 7, 2007 under the late entry rule. Entries made during the late entry time period will be charged an additional \$4.00 per entry. Entries close when pens or stalls are full.
2. Fees. Each Exhibitor must purchase at least one (5) day exhibitor ticket at \$12.00 each. The exhibitor ticket of \$12.00, entry fees and pen fees must accompany all applications for entry. No refunds on entry fees. Stall fees are paid only once for animals stalled on grounds. Please use the accompanying Open Boer Goat Entry Form. Please complete all sections for the entry form fully.
3. Health Papers will be checked at 1:00 Saturday, July 14. All exhibitors must furnish official health certificates as required by Illinois state law. No premiums will be paid if health papers are not checked. Animals are subject to rejection from the fairgrounds for appearance of contagious disease at the discretion of the fair officials. This includes but is not limited to severe diarrhea, pink eye, sore mouth, ringworm, or abscess in any stage. Injecting and/or drenching any substance except under the express supervision of a licensed veterinarian is not allowed and is grounds for dismissal.
4. Exhibitors are required to abide by the Heart of Illinois Fair, as listed in the General Rules Section, please print this section for your reference.
5. Exhibitors will be dismissed after entire show is completed.
6. ABGA rules shall govern. The superintendent will have a copy of the ABGA rules for reference.
7. All animals entered (except market wethers) must be registered with an approved registry association (IBGA, USBGA, ABGA). Exhibitors must show original certificates of registration. Animals with illegible tattoos or tattoos not matching their registration certificate will forfeit their award.
8. Only animals entered in the show will be allowed in the barns.
9. The base date for class entry will be the day of the show. Animals improperly classified forfeit their award.
10. No exhibitor may receive more than two monies in any one lot.
11. Market Class winners can be asked to weigh back with no more than a 5 pound difference in weight allowed. Market animals must show with their milk teeth. Goats with missing milk teeth or eruption of permanent teeth will be disqualified.
12. The Illinois Humane Care for Animals Act prohibits physical mistreatment of animals. No muzzles, no icing market animals. Withholding feed and/or water are considered direct violations of this act. Persons mistreating goats will be disqualified.
13. Any evidence of unethical practices will result in disqualification and premiums and awards will be withheld.
14. All waste bedding and manure must be placed in containers provided on the North Side of the livestock barns.
